Annual Appointment of Tenant Board Members of Newark and Sherwood Homes

Newark and Sherwood Homes' Board of Directors is made up of 15 people, 5 of these places are reserved for tenants.

All tenants have the opportunity to be a Tenant Board Member if they wish. There are rules and procedures that say how and when Board members are appointed. These have been followed and the tenant Directors of the Board who will retire at the Annual General Meeting on 12 November 2009 are Jean Clark and Richard Tracy.

A process to elect two tenants to the Board has now commenced. Firstly, any interested tenant should complete an Expression of Interest Form and a Candidate Statement. People expressing an interest will then be considered against the Role Criteria and Role Specification, after which candidates information for election will be passed to the Electoral Reform Service who will hold a ballot for tenants to elect two Tenant Board Members. Each tenant will receive one voting paper.

If you are interested in being on the Board as a Director, you will be involved in making decisions at the highest level in Newark and Sherwood Homes. The decisions you contribute to will set the direction for the Service to make sure it gets better and better.

The processes may be new, but don't be put off. If you have some time to give, which will involve attending Board meetings (approximately one every twelve weeks) training sessions (approximately once per month), Company events and Committee meetings (approximately one per month) and are interested, don't hesitate, send your Expression of Interest form and your Candidate Statement to us today.

There will be training and support to help you on your way.
