COLLINGHAM PARISH COUNCIL

DOGS IN THE GROUNDS

Byelaws made by the Parish Council of Collingham under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 in respect of pleasure grounds

EXTENT

- 1. (1) These byelaws apply to the open spaces named in the Schedule and hereinafter referred to as "the Grounds".
- (2) Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given by signs placed in conspicuous positions in or near each of the Grounds.

INTERPRETATION

- In these byelaws:-
 - (1) "the Council" means the Parish Council of Collingham.
- (2) For the purpose of these byelaws the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless at the time when the dog entered or remained on the Grounds it had been placed or taken into the charge of some other person.
- (3) In paragraph (2) above "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

DOGS PROHIBITED FROM THE GROUNDS

- 3. (1) No person (other than a registered blind person) in charge of a dog shall without reasonable excuse, permit the dog to enter or remain in the Grounds.
- (2) An officer of the Council or any constable may require a person in charge of a dog which has entered the Grounds to remove the dog from the Grounds.

REMOVAL OF OFFENDERS

4. Any person offending against byelaw 3(1) may be removed from the Grounds by any officer of the Council or any constable.

PENALTY

5. Any person offending against byelaw 3(1) shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 of the standard scale.
